- Providing safe places for people to live, work, meet, learn and play.

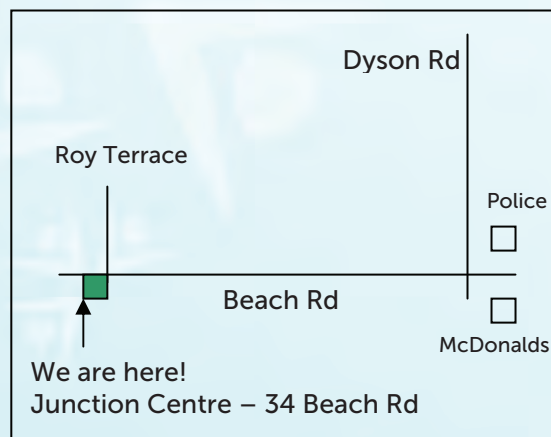
At Junction Australia we firmly believe that by working together, we can take steps that enable people to navigate their way from 'Crisis to Connectedness'.

Parent Adolescent Counselling Service

The Parent Adolescent Counselling Services of Junction Australia aims to support families with 12-18 year old young people to work with the changes and challenges of adolescence.

The goal of the service is to reduce family conflict, prevent family breakdown and work towards preventing young people from experiencing homelessness.

Our Charges

Fees are charged on a sliding scale, according to household income. An inability to pay is not a barrier to accessing our services.

Hourly Fee	Household Income
\$10	0 - \$20,000
\$20	\$20,000 - \$35,000
\$30	\$35,000 - \$45,000
\$40	\$45,000 - \$70,000
\$50	\$70,000 - \$100,000
\$60	Over \$100,000



Services include

Counselling

For individuals and families.

Negotiation and Mediation

Work towards resolving issues between young people, parents and other family members.

Conflict Resolution

Offering independent guidance so that parents and adolescents can both speak and be heard.

Problem Solving Strategies

Assisting parents and young people to work together, to explore options and find solutions.

Work to Prevent Homelessness

Working through issues which may prevent young people becoming homeless.

Parenting Courses

Promoting and supporting the development of effective parenting skills and healthy, thriving families.

Information and Referral

Connecting you with other resources and relevant supports.



Eligibility

These services are offered specifically to families:

- Experiencing conflict and/or difficulties relating to each other
- Who want to work towards better relationships
- Where a young person could remain at home or return home if problems could be resolved.

These services are:

- Confidential (subject to legal reporting obligations)
- Available by telephone or face to face
- Available for all family members.
