The Toward Home Service Model

As of 1 July, these organisations will be working together to offer a range of services to people who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness. The help available includes:

- 'Prevent' for those at risk of homelessness
- 'Divert' for people who have recently found themselves experiencing homelessness
- 'Toward Home Wardli-ana' for Aboriginal people experiencing homelessness, and
- 'Resolve' for people who have been experiencing homelessness long term

These organisations also provide other supports that may be of help to you. When contacting the Toward Home Alliance, or speaking to one of our workers, make sure you ask about other assistance and help that may be available for you.
